



## TEN CHIMNEYS

### WHAT YOUR DONATION CAN BUY

**{\$18}** One package of museum-grade archival tissue paper used to protect the estate's diverse collections, comprised of the original pieces hand picked by the Lunts in the 1920s, '30s, and '40s.

**{\$23}** One year's supply of cotton gloves for Volunteer Docents.

With estate tours five days a week, our tour leaders refrain from touching even the brass door handles with their bare hands.

**{\$75}** Annual tuning of the Noël Coward Piano. This one-of-a-kind Steinway comes to life once every year for our *Music in the Drawing Room* program.

**{\$100}** One hotel night for a distinguished lecturer in our *Conversations at Ten Chimneys* series. This year's honored guests have included the great Lynn Redgrave and Broadway scholar Leonard Jacobs.

**{\$200}** Yearly CPR and defibrillator training for the entire staff.

**{\$300}** Annual chimney inspection and cleaning for all ten chimneys on the historic estate . . . Darling, we simply must take care of those chimneys.

**{\$500}** Annual maintenance for and updates to our *Permanent Exhibition, "The Lunts: A Life on Stage."* This exhibition makes the perfect companion to estate tours, but is also an important stand-alone exhibition for school groups, arts professionals, and guests of all ages. Admission to both the permanent and annual exhibitions is always open to the public and free of charge.

## MORE OF . . .

### WHAT YOUR DONATION CAN BUY

**{\$1,500}** The full cost of our collaborative *High School Conservatory Program*.

**{\$3,000}** Supplies for Preservation Volunteers for a full year. Every week, a corps of devoted volunteers lavish much-needed care and elbow grease to the estate — just as Lynn and Alfred did.

**{\$4,679}** Comprehensive insurance for one month. Of the nearly 80,000 properties on the *National Register of Historic Places*, less than 3% have been designated as *National Historic Landmarks* — and Ten Chimneys is only the 10th Landmark in the entire country related to theatre.

**{\$8,214}** Electricity for the historic Main House and Cottage for a full year. The Main House alone has 14 rooms.

**{\$10,000}** The full cost of our *Annual Exhibition*. Our 2010 exhibition will celebrate the 75th anniversary of the Lunts' legendary production of *The Taming of the Shrew*, which eventually inspired the musical *Kiss Me, Kate*. Our 2007 Noël Coward exhibition, after installations at *The National Theatre* in London, and at *The Museum of Performance & Design* in San Francisco, is heading to Hollywood . . . In January 2010, it will open at the *Academy of Motion Picture Arts & Sciences* — where it will run through the *Academy Awards*.

And less than **{2¢}** for this bookmark. An impressive 93% of our annual budget is spent directly on the programs and services we exist to provide. Only 7% is spent on general administration and fundraising. These statistics are quite remarkable compared to national averages for nonprofits.
